2/13/19	11:00:00 AM	Plaintiff, Oliver Brown filed a class-action suit against the Board of Education of Topeka, Kansas, in 1951, after his daughter, Linda Brown, was denied entrance to Topeka's all-white elementary schools. Justices on the Brown v. Board case agreed unanimously that racial segregation of children in public schools was unconstitutional. 2/15/19	10:00:00 AM	In its verdict of Brown v. Board, the Supreme Court did not specify how exactly schools should be integrated, and gears changed slowly. It wasn't until September 1957 that the "Little Rock Nine," as the nine teens came to be known, would be the first African American students to enter Little Rock's Central High School, eight arriving together for the first day of school. 2/18/19	10:30:00 AM	At the tender age of six, Ruby Bridges advanced the cause of civil rights in November 1960 when she became the first African American student to integrate an elementary school in the South. After passing an entrance exam to see whether she could compete academically at an all-white school, Ruby and her mother were escorted by four federal marshals to the school every day. She ate lunch alone and sometimes played with her teacher at recess, but she never missed a day of school that year. Typically, we hear these disparities described as gaps in achievement, opportunity, wealth, etc., but there's also the Belief Gap. • Consider these facts: Most low-income students with good grades don't even bother to apply to top colleges. Minority students are far less likely to enroll in talented and gifted programs.
